Your guide to recreation in Appomattox

BOATING, CANOING & SWIMMING

Holliday Lake: Clear, cold, relatively deep. Gas motors prohibited. Open year round from daylight to dark. Rt 24 E, Right on 626, Left on 640. 434 248-6308

James River: Boating, Canoeing and Kayaking. Class I and II rapids, riffles and rock gardens. Boat access at Bent Creek Hwy 26 and Rt 60.

Paradise Lake: Clear spring fed lake with white sand beach for swimming. Canoe and Paddleboat rentals. Open year round. Hwy 460, 6 mi W of Appomattox 434 993-3332

James River State Park: 1,442 acre park with three miles of Riverfront and two boat ramps offer access to the James River. Year round. 434 933-4355

James River State Park Outdoor Adventures Full service livery, canoe, kayak, tube and bicycle rentals. May-September. Rts 26/60 434 933-8682

FISHING

Appomattox-Buckingham State Forest - two Clear lakes with bass, crappie, sunfish, chain pickerel and northern pike. Stocked trout area as well. Two mile fishing trail. No gas motors. 434 983-2175

James River State Park - Prime habitat for sunfish and small and largemouth bass. From 26/60 take 605 for 7 mi 434 933-4355

Holliday Lake State Park - Bass, crappie, sunfish, chain pickerel and northern pike.

HUNTING

Appomattox-Buckingham State Forest - A 19,535 acre forest hosting two lakes and stocked trout fishing area. Abundant deer, turkey and many small game species such as squirrel and quail. 434 983-2175

PARKS & TRAILS

Appomattox History Trail - Easy to moderate 6 mile historic trail that follows the last hours of the Confederacy. Begins and ends at the Appomattox Court House National Historical Park Visitor Center. 434 352-8987

Holliday Lake State Park - 5 1/2 mile lakeshore trail providing great views of wildlife in the woods and on the lake. 434 248-6308

Carter Taylor Multi-Use Trail - 12 mile loop trail with diverse terrain. Welcome hikers, horseback riders and bicycles. 434 983-2175 or 434 248-6308

James River State Park - Three loop trails 5 miles in length. Trails are wide and easy to moderate. Horseback riders welcome. 434 933-4355

Appomattox Town Park - Family park containing playground equipment and picnic pavilions. Daily dawn to dusk. 434 352-8268

Abbutt Park - Peaceful and landscaped with picnic tables. Available for special occasions. 434 352-8268

Appomattox Community Park - Multiple fields for baseball, softball, soccer and football. Hiking and biking trails and picnic area. 434 352-5996
